

Vacancy: Finance Intern

Headquartered in Barcelona, the Institute for Integrated Transitions (IFIT) is a nongovernmental organisation dedicated to helping fragile and conflict-affected states achieve more sustainable negotiations and transitions out of war or authoritarianism. IFIT's core work is to serve as an expert resource on integrated policy solutions for locally-led efforts to break cycles of conflict or repression.

IFIT is currently looking for a motivated **finance intern** to join our team in the **Barcelona office** for a period of 6 months, starting in January 2025.

The selected responsibilities will include:

• Support the financial administration of the organisation by compiling and processing accurate financial and accounting information.

• Assist the Financial Manager and Assistant by ensuring accurate recording of financial transactions in IFIT's accounting system (managed by an external company) in line with IFIT's financial and accounting policies.

• Liaise with IFIT's financial service providers (banks, external accountants, auditors, etc.).

• Support the maintenance and update of internal tools for financial management (income forecast, expenditure reports, among others).

- Support the process of payments and tracking of bank deposits and payments.
- Support the preparation of monthly, quarterly and annual financial reports and financial statements under the guidance of the Financial Manager.
- Assist in the annual audit process and other project audits.

• Support fundraising activities with the preparation of project budgets and financial reports for donors.

Conditions:

Although the internship is unpaid, IFIT offers: 1) reimbursement of travel to or from Barcelona for the purposes of the internship (up to a maximum of 500€), and 2) partial offset of specific living costs incurred by undertaking the internship in Barcelona (up to a maximum of 900€ per month).
